


# **WASH CARE SYMBOLS**

As a retailer or fashion brand, it is your duty to ensure that wash care labels serve as accurate guides for customers in how to care for their garments.

There are five main symbols .







# **BLEACHING**

The triangle indicates whether the article may or may not be bleached.



Any Bleach Allowed



Only Oxygen Bleach Allowed



Do Not Bleach

#### **DRYING**

The square is the symbol of the drying process. The circle in the square is a reference to tumble drying.

The dots within the iron symbol indicate the temperature range to be used.

## **PROFESSIONAL CARE**

The circle symbol indicates whether the garment isn suitable for dry cleaning and what solvents are safe to use.
